I leave my coat, bag, lunch, drink & snack out here, then I am ready to start my day!

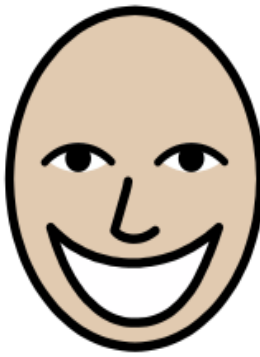
Saying Goodbye

Sometimes it feels difficult.



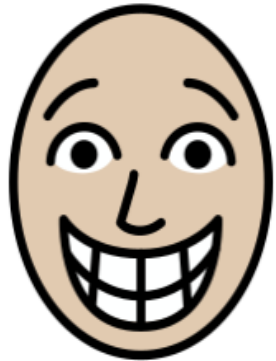
Sad

I can paint, draw and make things.

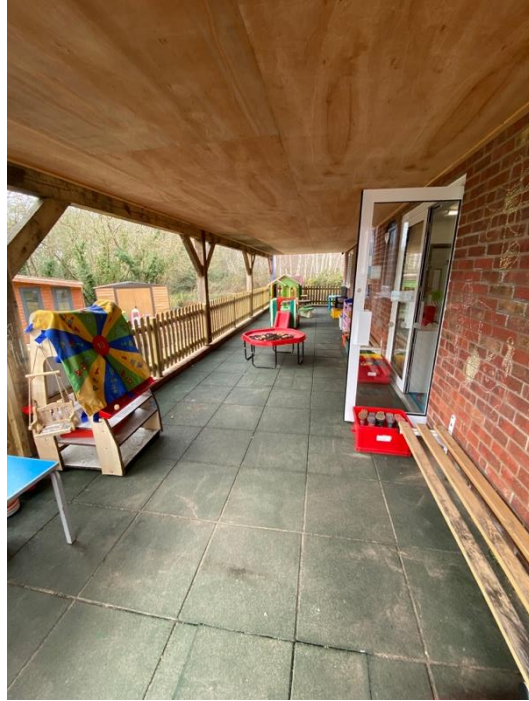
Sensory Room

Courtyard & Garden



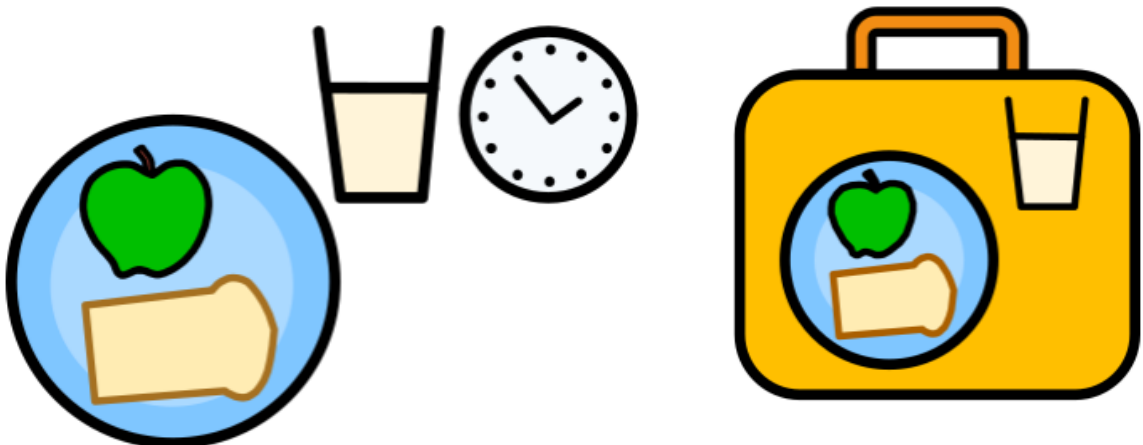
We have a fabulous outside space both in the courtyard where you can play and stay dry or out in the main garden, with so much to experience!

I can have a healthy snack or lunch and a drink with my friends.



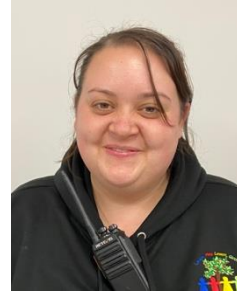

A Note for Parents
